

**REAP/HRDP Emergency Grants
State Historical Society of Iowa**

The Emergency REAP/HRDP program uses the same application form as the regular REAP/HRDP program. This application can be found at:

The differences between the regular grant application process and the emergency application process are as follows:

- You must submit a cover letter that explains the threat to the resource.
- The threat to the resource cannot be due to delinquency on the part of the current owner.
- The maximum grant request is \$15,000
- Submit five copies of the grant application (The regular round only calls for one copy). You still only need to submit two copies of the contract with original signatures.
- There is no specific deadline – submit the application as soon as it is ready.
- The review process is different. There is a staff grants steering committee that reviews the applications. This process only takes a couple of weeks.
- Property does not have to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places, but State Historic Preservation Office staff does have to determine the property eligible for the National Register.
